Nau Mai Haere Mai RATIFICATION OF NGAATI WHANAUNGA POST SETTLEMENT GOVERNANCE ENTITY and ON-ACCOUNT ARRANGEMENT

The mandated negotiators for Ngaati Whanaunga have been negotiating with the Crown since 2009 in relation to the treaty settlement of Ngaati Whanaunga.

In order to receive the redress from the Taamaki, Hauraki and Marutuuahu Collective's, and Ngaati Whanaunga iwi-specific redress, Ngaati Whanaunga negotiators and Ngaati Whanaunga mandated body has negotiated with Crown; a post settlement governance entity (PSGE) and an on-account redress arrangement in advance of the full settlement of the historical Treaty of Waitangi claim.

The people of Ngaati Whanaunga can now vote whether to accept the PSGE and an on-account arrangement, the following resolutions;

I, as a member of Ngaati Whanaunga agree that the Ngaati Whanaunga Ruunanga Trust will be the Post-Settlement Governance Entity and the recipient of Ngaati Whanaunga Treaty Settlement Redress.

I as a member of Ngaati Whanaunga approve the purchase by the Ngaati Whanaunga Ruunanga Trust of a property at Te Kouma with up to \$1.6 million of the Ngaati Whanaunga financial and commercial redress amount on-account of settlement.

To assist with informed voting, the following information hui will be held to present information on and discuss the Ngaati Whanaunga Ruunanga Trust PSGE and on-account arrangement

Alternatively, a special voting pack can be obtained at the information hui. Special votes, which are otherwise valid, will be counted subject to confirmation of registration.

The voting period will commence on 17th July 2014 and closes 5pm 14th August 2014
